Terms and Conditions for Selling Materials to Total Building Materials

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") apply to any materials you ("the Seller") sell or offer to sell to Total Building Materials ("we," "our," or "us"). By selling materials to us, you agree to these Terms.

1. Ownership and Authority
